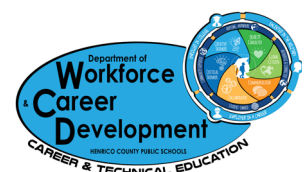

CAREER AMBASSADORS

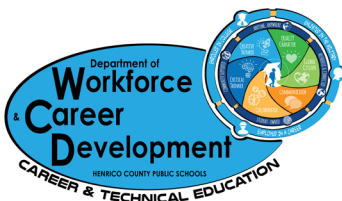
